

# WiOO: redefining the concept of the Smart light switch

A revolutionary and "illuminating" product lands at CES 2022 to be introduced to the USA market

WiDesign, an Italian startup specializing in designing and producing innovative products dedicated to the Smart Home, introduces its first consumer product for the American market: WiOO, a system that completely redesigns and redefines the very concept of the "light switch." Rather than just switching on and off the lights or other house appliances, WiOO serves as a central controller in the modern home.

WiOO perfectly reflects the WiDesign philosophy: It's easy to use, functional, and beautiful.

WiOO easily integrates into any home and operates as soon as it is connected. It can be installed on the wall using the housing of regular switches, it doesn't require any changes, and it can control a light point even if placed in another room. It is unique and simple, yet features some of the most complex and innovative technology in the IoT world. It is totally and naturally integrated with the Apple HomeKit system (\*), allowing the management of its many functionalities – and there are many of them! – directly from an iPhone using Siri.

The WiOO system is available in two units, the WiOO Master Switch that wirelessly connects to and coordinates up to 30 WiOO Switches, without requiring any hubs or any additional hardware. Thanks to the WiOO app, all the WiOO Switches are automatically detected and a mesh network is created to link them to the home Master. We call it functional because "it just works." It controls any on-off switch, both Smart and standard light bulbs, home appliances, doors, blinds, and music of the Apple HomeKit ecosystem. But it's more than just a switch; we like to call it a "lighting body" because the LED halo with customizable color, brightness and animations allows WiOO to detect motion and show programmed events in endless combinations. The same LED halo can also be changed to reflect unlimited moods, serving as an interior design element.

Characteristics of world-famous Italian design are incorporated into WiOO. It is available in black and white versions, and both integrate beautifully into any environment.

Safety is also very important to the WiOO project: WiOO doesn't just manage all your household appliances with seamless integration with Apple HomeKit and Siri, but protects the house and its occupants. Its integrated sensor can detect motion, and activate light signals for alerts and notifications. It can set up courtesy lights that turn on when someone walks by, eliminating the need to switch on lights manually. WiOO can also turn on cameras



and video door-phones remotely and control everything based on conditions you decide: even the weather. An upcoming update to the WiOO app will allow users to program the system to function when they are not home and simulate their daily habits in the house. The entire system has been designed with external components that work with low power and take advantage of all the strict protocols of Apple HomeKit to protect the user's privacy.

The American market is sure to appreciate the innovation, style, and functionalities of this revolutionary device.
